

2017 European Bioeconomy Congress Registration Policy

1. Organizer, contractor and personal data controller

1. The 2017 European Bioeconomy Congress (the “Congress”) is organized by the Marshal’s Office of the Lodzkie Region (Urząd Marszałkowski Województwa Łódzkiego) with its registered office in Łódź at al. Piłsudskiego 8 (the “Organizer”).
2. The Congress is being prepared, organized and supported on behalf of the Organizer by a consortium consisting of:
 - a. PHIN Consulting Sp. z o.o. with its registered office in Łódź at ul. Częstochowska 63, 93-121 Łódź, listed in the National Court Register kept by the District Court for Łódź-Śródmieście in Łódź, 20th Division of the National Court Register, under KRS no. 0000249739, NIP (tax ID) 725-19-30-680, REGON (statistical ID) 100246778, and
 - b. Krzysztof Fudała, doing business as JMK Krzysztof Fudała, ul. Pszeniczna 49, 92-701 Wódka, NIP (tax ID) 727-165-10-84, REGON (statistical ID) 100134677.
3. The data controller for the personal data provided by prospective Congress attendees is the Board of the Lodzkie Region (Zarząd Województwa Łódzkiego) with its registered office in Łódź at al. Piłsudskiego 8.
4. The consortium of PHIN Consulting Sp. z o.o. and Krzysztof Fudała processes prospective Congress attendees’ personal data under a personal data processing agreement as required to complete the registration process and to organize and support the Congress.
5. Every prospective Congress attendee has the right to access, correct and delete his/her data.
6. While the provision of personal data is voluntary, it is a prerequisite for attendance at the Congress.
7. By attending the Congress, the attendee agrees that he/she may be photographed, filmed or recorded by other means without compensation and that his/her voice and likeness may be broadcasted, disseminated or displayed (without the requirement to obtain approval in each case). The above consent covers the use, recording, editing and duplication of the photographs and videos taken, via any media, for the Province’s promotional and informational purposes, including use in any promotional or informational materials to be developed and publication on websites or in media communications.
8. This Policy becomes effective upon publication on the www.bioeconomy.lodzkie.pl website. The Organizer reserves the right to amend this Policy.

2. Congress registration terms and conditions

1. Registration is open to attendees from October 4, 2017 to November 16, 2017.
2. The Organizer may extend the attendee registration period.

3. Registration will also be possible during the Congress, between 9:00 AM and 2:00 PM.
4. By registering and submitting the registration form provided on the Congress website, the attendee accepts the provisions of this Policy and agrees to comply with regulations and any other arrangements made between the attendee and the Organizer.
5. Individuals interested in attending the Congress may register exclusively through the www.bioeconomy.lodzkie.pl website, which contains the REGISTRATION FORM.
6. As a prerequisite for successful registration, it is necessary to complete all the required fields in the REGISTRATION FORM available at www.bioeconomy.lodzkie.pl and to grant consent for personal data processing.
7. The Organizer reserves the right to verify and approve Congress attendees' enrollment requests.
8. Every attendee who completes the registration process will receive automatic confirmation of enrollment for the Congress by e-mail within 48 hours.
